Internal impact

- Assess current carbon emissions and environmental impact.
- Establish clear oversight and accountability for emissions reduction within the organization.
- Identify internal stakeholders who will be involved in the development of a SAF strategy.
- Set emission reduction targets and timeline to guide the strategy.

Market

- Research the regulatory landscape and incentives related to SAF adoption.
- Understand the demand for SAF within your operating region.
- Analyze market trends and forecasts for SAF pricing and availability.
- Identify potential partners, suppliers, and collaborators in the SAF value chain.

Product

- Gain a comprehensive understanding of different SAF production processes (e.g., feedstock, technologies).
- Evaluate the various types of SAF available and their environmental benefits.
- Understand the difference between physical fuel and SAFc.
- Define acceptable incentives.
